

St John's Lutheran Primary School 2020 School Fee Information

St John's Lutheran Primary School prides itself on providing a quality Christian education that is affordable to all members of the community. The School fee includes:

- **all curriculum delivery**
- **all curriculum-based excursions** (such as the cost of bus & entry fees)
- **all school arranged sporting events** (such as the cost of bus)
- **all visiting performers**

Items that are not included are, uniform and camps.

Enrolment Establishment fee: \$100 is payable as a commitment to St John's Lutheran Primary School for a Foundation student's enrolment at the School for the next year. This is an advance payment of tuition fees and is credited to your account at the start of the year. It is non-refundable except in mitigating circumstances.

Fee payment: Fees will be charged in full at the beginning of the year and can be settled in the following methods:

- Paid in full by 29 February 2020 attracting a 4% discount
- Paid in termly instalments due on 7th February, 17th April, 17th July & 16th October
- Paid monthly from February to November, on 2nd Friday of each month.
- Paid in weekly, fortnightly or monthly instalments from Credit Card, Payroll Deduction or Direct Debit.

Many parents find it convenient to make regular payments via payroll, direct debit or credit card deduction. Please contact the Business Manager if you wish to arrange this.

Affordability: When a family has more than one child enrolled at the School in a given year, the following discounts apply:

- **20%** reduction in fees for the second child
- **35%** reduction in fees for the third child
- **75%** reduction in fees for the fourth and subsequent child/children

Fees: Yearly fees for 2020 per student are as follows:

Foundation: \$1,127

Year 1: \$1,312

Year 2: \$1,576

Year 3: \$1,857

Year 4: \$2,012

Year 5: \$2,126

Year 6: \$2,169

A **discount of 4%** is available if the full year's fee is paid in full by 29 February 2020.

Fee Concession will be considered in cases of need. Cases are discussed individually and confidentially. It is the policy of the school to make it possible for all who genuinely wish to send their children to St John's Lutheran Primary School, to be able to do so.
